

Message

Dear Colleagues:

TOPIC 2005 (TOkyo Percutaneous coronary Intervention Conference) was a great success, with some 1600 people attending. We should like to express our heartfelt thanks to the doctors, co-medical professionals and medical equipment companies who have supported this event.

With the arrival in the Japanese market of drug-eluting stents (DES), which has had a huge impact, the era of percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) has become well established here. It is now time for us to consider where we are today and where we should be going. The diffusion rate of DES is now over 70 per cent. Re-examination of its efficacy and its long-term effects, as well as follow-ups of problems, have revealed new issues that need to be resolved. In this context, intravascular ultrasound (IVUS)-guided PCI, which is influenced by the high diffusion of IVUS, has an important role to play. It is anticipated that the efficacy of treating lesions in the left main trunk and bifurcation with DES and the treatment technique for chronic total occlusion (CTO), which Japanese doctors are known to be good at, will be further improved.

Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI) re-perfusion, an intervention therapy for acute coronary syndromes, to which the hard-working Japanese are susceptible, is also entering a new phase. On the other hand, arteriosclerosis lesion does not remain inside the coronary artery. Though it might be a little too late, the use of, and interest in, peripheral intervention have increased enormously in recent times and involve all of us.

Moreover, a solution to the fundamental problem of the formation and development of plaque is being brought closer by the development and use of a new diagnostic technology called plaque analysis. It has been indicated recently that intervention therapy can be used to treat not only ischemic heart disease but also valvular and congenital heart conditions.

We believe that, in order to obtain a clearer picture of advanced medicine, Japanese PCI therapy needs to be discussed from a global standpoint, with experts and professionals from around the world.

TOPIC 2005's program was more ambitious than last year's. We believe that the significantly larger number of people taking part in the Conference proves that the latter has fulfilled its role. In TOPIC 2006, we should like to cooperate with all of you based on the progress hitherto in order to further develop the mainstream of PCI, which will become apparent in the near future.

TOPIC 2006 will take place between Thursday, July 20th and Saturday July 22nd at the Cerulean Tower Tokyu Hotel, the same location as last year. We extend to each and every one of you our warmest invitation to attend, and sincerely hope that you will enjoy lively discussions, undeterred by the high temperatures of mid-summer Japan.






